Precinct Officials

Precinct officials, also called poll workers, operate the polls during early voting and on Election Day. Duties performed include setting up the voting equipment, checking in voters, issuing ballots, assisting voters with special needs, and closing down/securing the voting site at the end of the day.

Qualifications

- Be 18 and a registered voter in Pender County
- Have great communication and customer service skills
- Not currently be an office-holder, candidate or near relative of a candidate, or treasurer of an open committee
- Not currently be an official of a political party, including precinct party officials
- Be able to work the entire day on Election Day at 5:30 am until at least 8:30 pm
 - this may involve sitting or standing for extended periods of time
- Have moderate computer skills
