MANDATORY EVACUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Pender County has been made aware of the status of Hurricane Florence:
and

WHEREAS, as the strength and damage potential of Hurricane Florence to the safety of the residents along the Intercoastal Waterway, low-lying coastal regions, flood-prone areas of the county that may be impacted to tidal surge and heavy rains; and

WHEREAS, major hurricane winds can damage manufactured or structures that can't withstand major hurricane winds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in the interest of public safety of the residents of low-lying, flood prone areas of the County along the Intercoastal Waterway, Northeast Cape Fear River, Black River, or who live in manufactured or homes not strong enough to sustain major hurricane winds, effective Sept. 11, 2018, and shall remain in effect until rescinded by the Chairman of the Board of the Pender County Commissioners.
