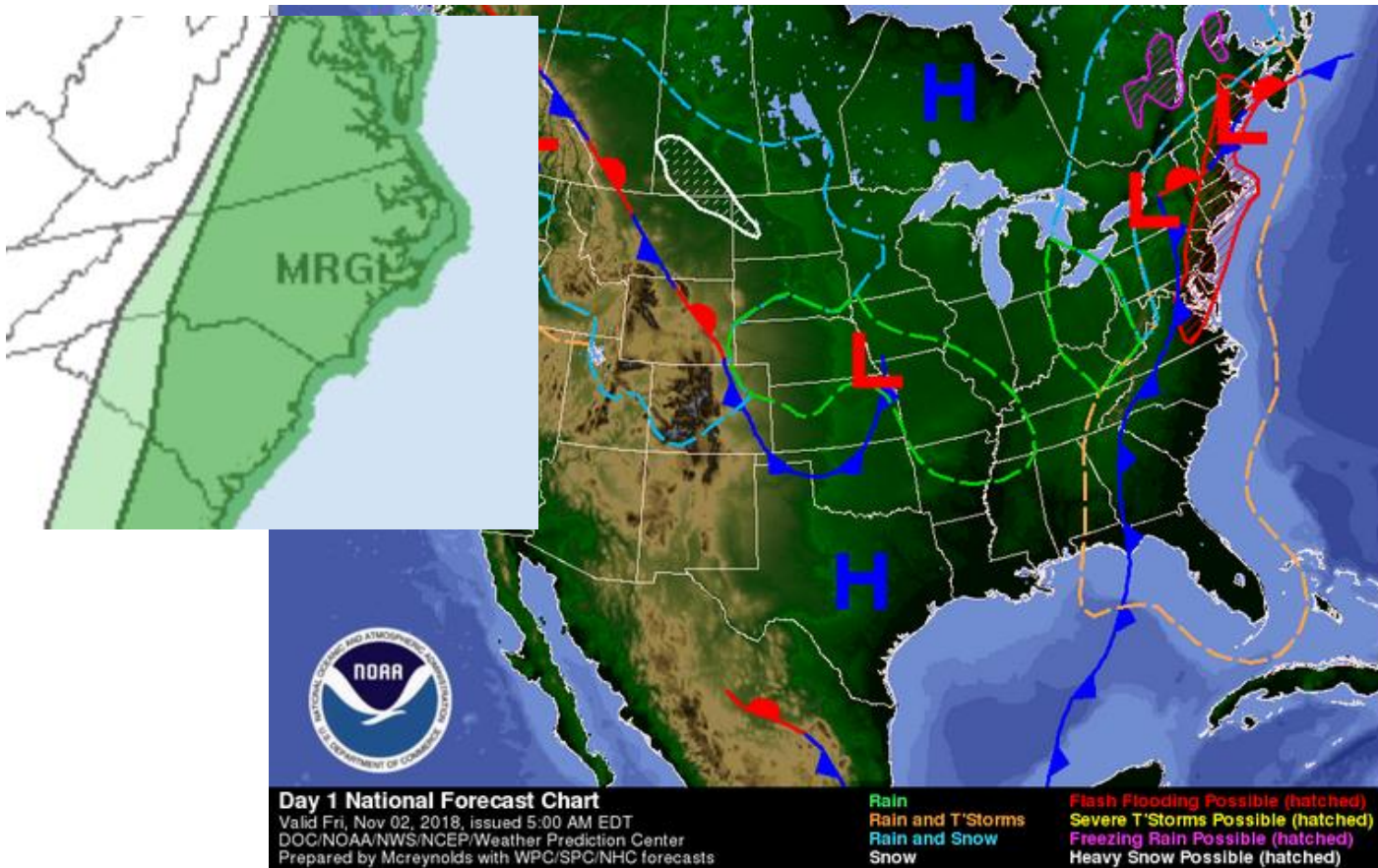

Marginal risk of severe thunderstorms this afternoon and evening.

Overview: A cold front will pass through the area today and tonight, stall well off the coast Saturday and move back to the west Sunday and Sunday night. Scattered to numerous showers and thunderstorms are expected ahead and along the front. There is also a small chance of showers Sunday with a greater chance Sunday night.

Impacts: There is a marginal risk that the storms could produce damaging wind gusts, mainly late this afternoon into this evening.

Timing/Confidence: Confidence is high that showers and a few thunderstorms will develop today into this evening. Confidence in damaging winds occurring is low.
