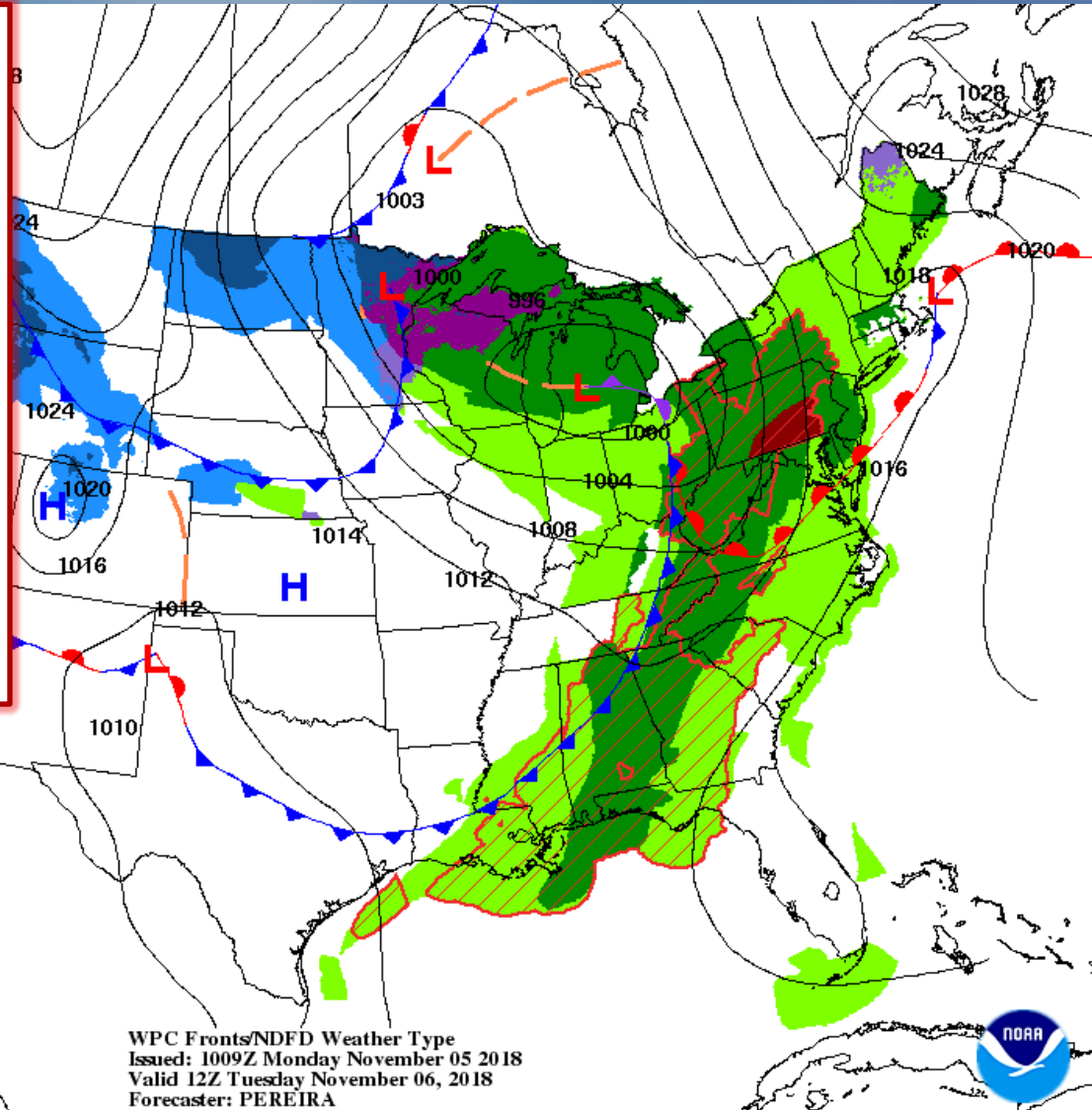
## Highlights

- Scattered showers today will become more isolated tonight as a warm front moves north of the area.
- **A cold front could bring strong to severe thunderstorms Tuesday afternoon and evening, especially across the inland portion of the Carolinas.**
- The front will linger near the coast through Friday. Periods of rain will become possible Wednesday through Friday as waves of low pressure develop along the stalled front.
- **Temperatures should run 5-10 degrees above normal through the week.**

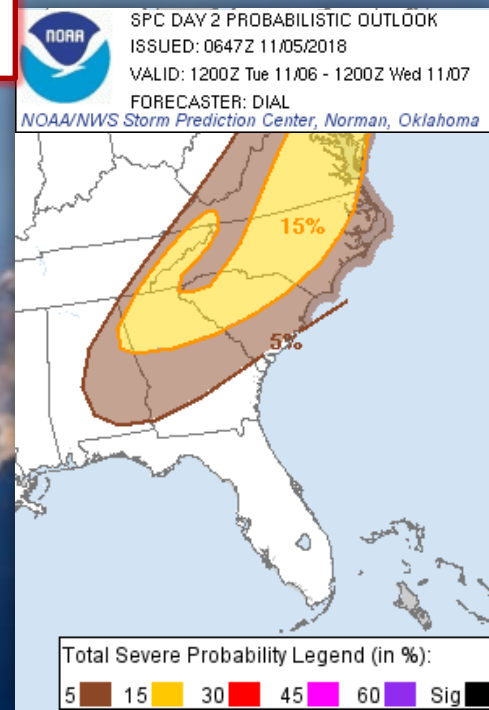
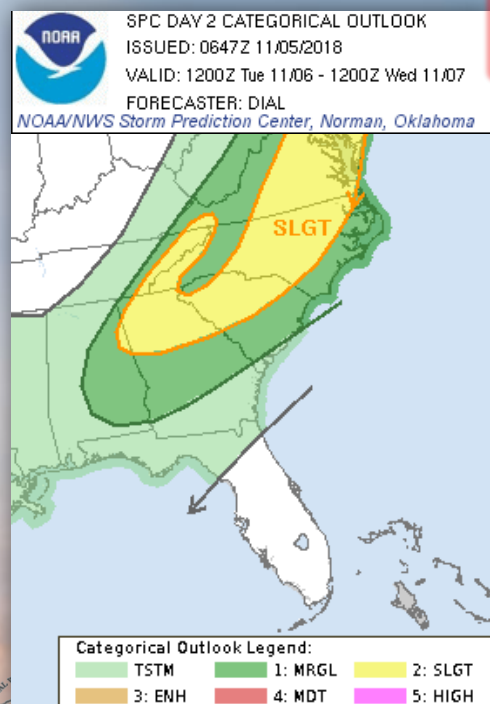
A cold front along the western edge of the Appalachians Tuesday morning will slide through the eastern Carolinas Tuesday night, bringing showers and thunderstorms.

# Severe Weather Outlook: Tuesday

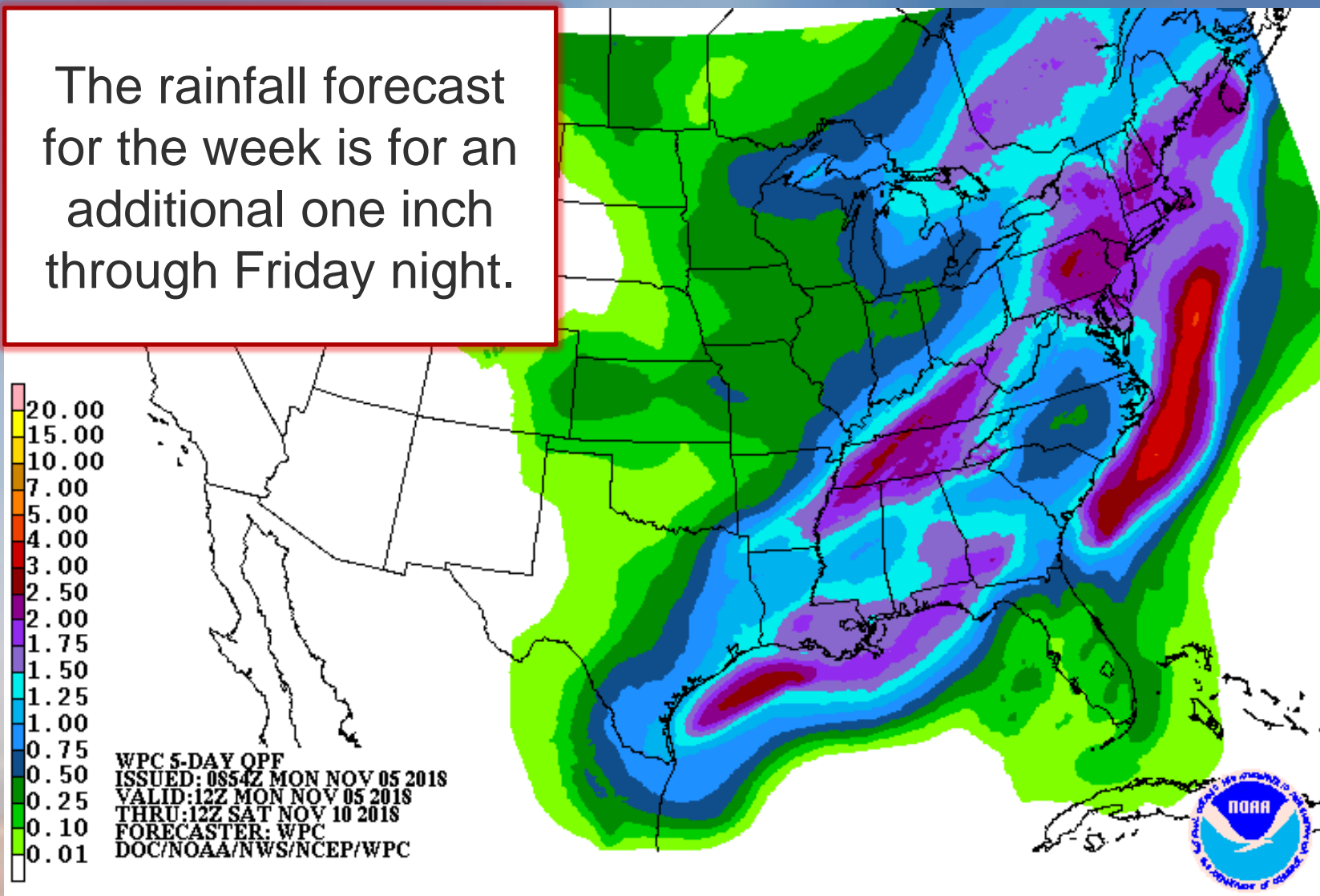

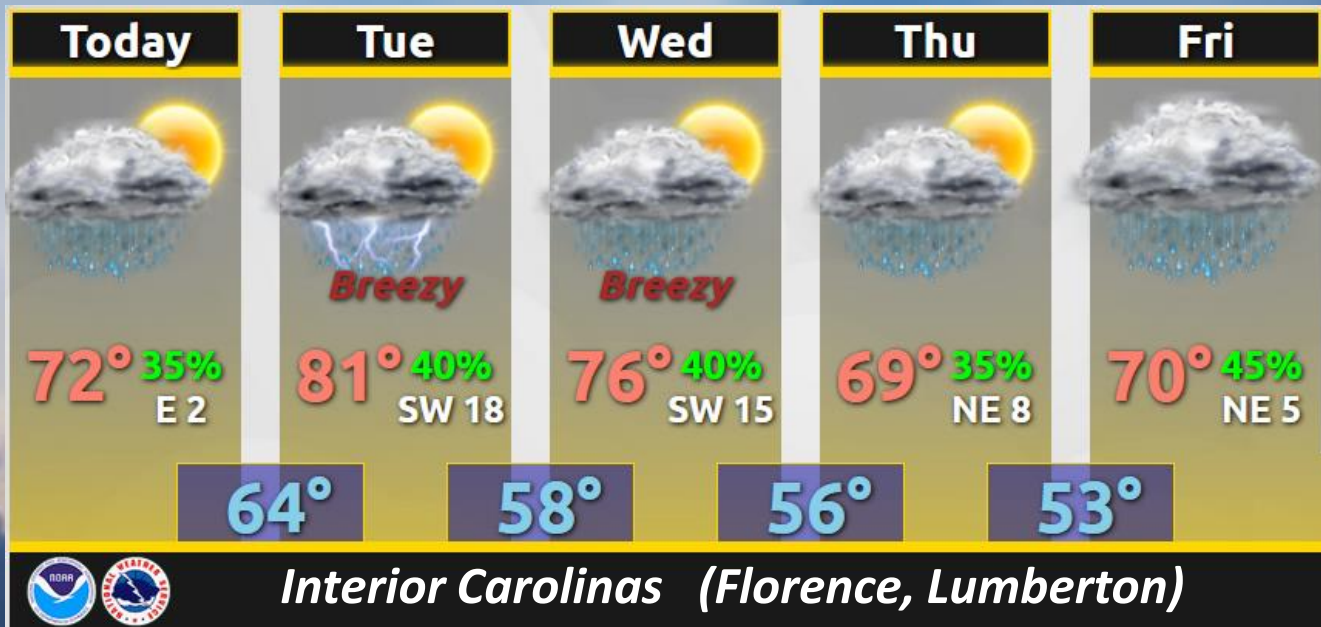
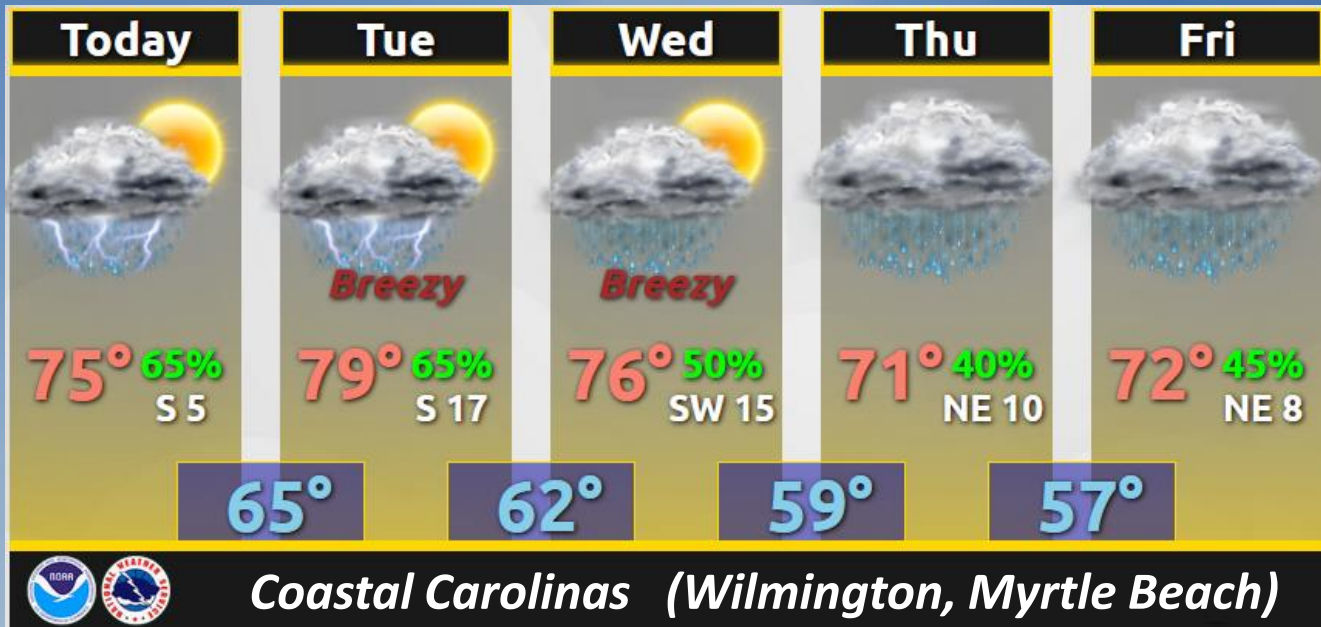




## Forecast Rainfall Thursday - Friday Night
