



Highlights

- Scattered showers today will become more isolated tonight as a warm front moves north of the area.
- A cold front could bring strong to severe thunderstorms Tuesday afternoon and evening, especially across the inland portion of the Carolinas.
- The front will linger near the coast through Friday.
 Periods of rain will become possible Wednesday through Friday as waves of low pressure develop along the stalled front.
- Temperatures should run 5-10 degrees above normal through the week.






Severe Weather Outlook: Tuesday

There is a slight risk of severe storms inland Tuesday afternoon into Tuesday evening, with a lesser potential near the coast. Damaging wind gusts is the largest potential threat.











Forecast Rainfall Thursday - Friday Night
