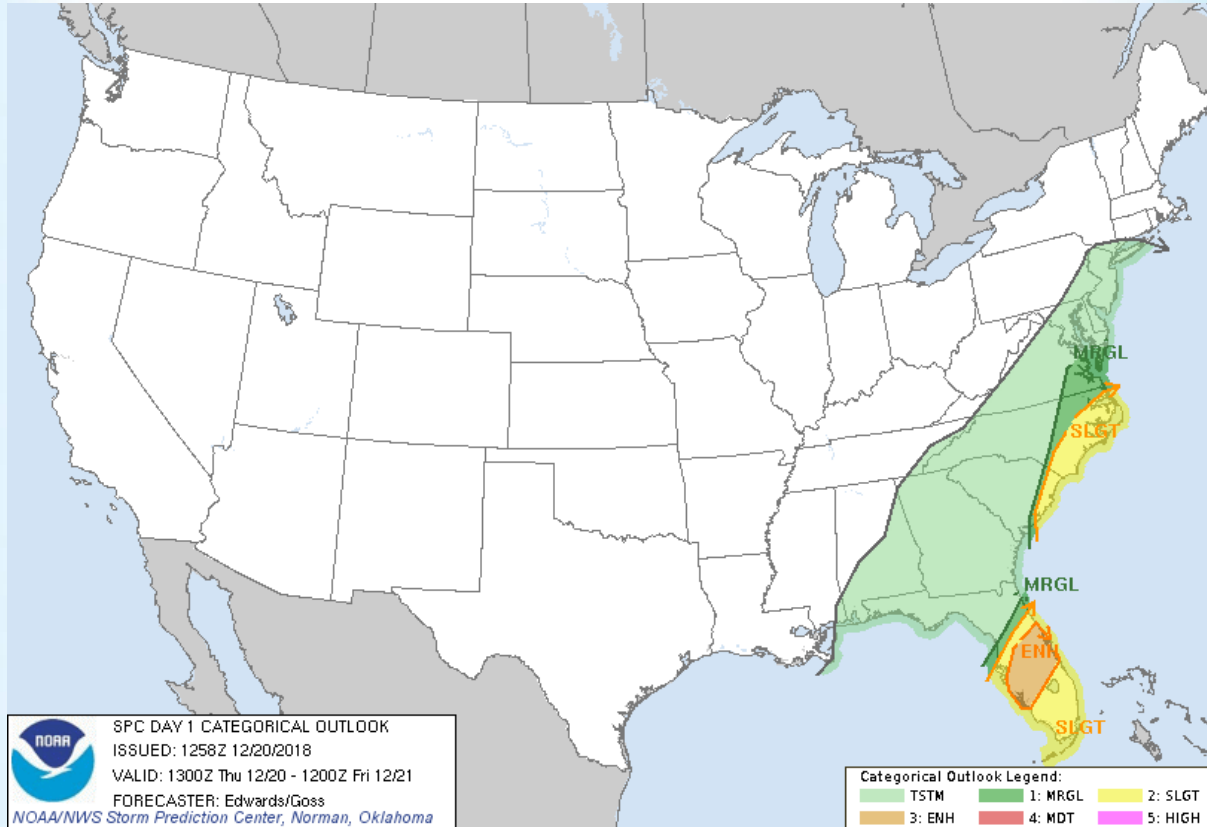

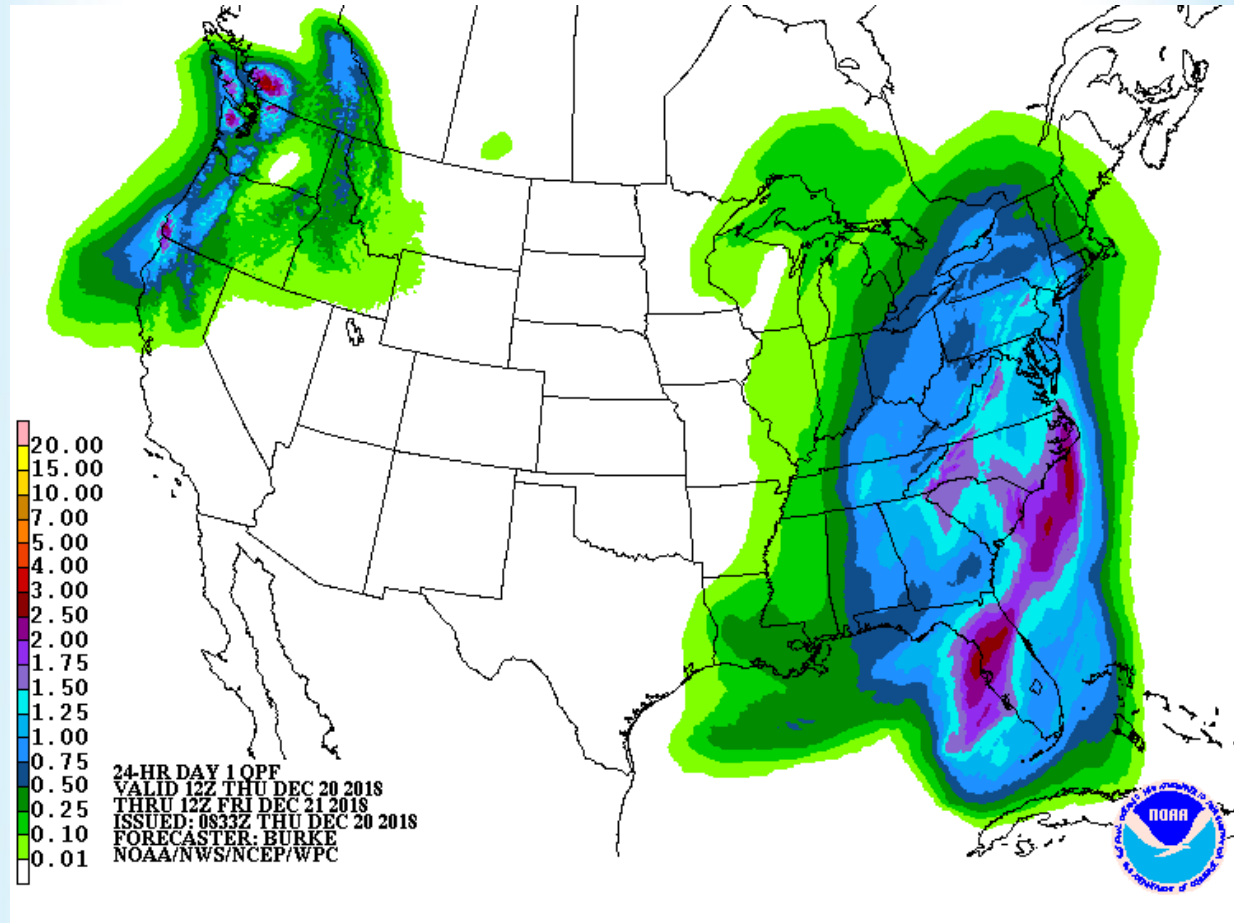

Severe Weather Outlook



THUNDERSTORMS (no label)	1 - MARGINAL (MRGL)	2 - SLIGHT (SLGT)	3 - ENHANCED (ENH)	4 - MODERATE (MDT)	5 - HIGH (HIGH)
No severe* thunderstorms expected	Isolated severe thunderstorms possible	Scattered severe storms possible	Numerous severe storms possible	Widespread severe storms likely	Widespread severe storms expected
Lightning/flooding threats exist with <u>all</u> thunderstorms	Limited in duration and/or coverage and/or intensity	Short-lived and/or not widespread, isolated intense storms possible	More persistent and/or widespread, a few intense	Long-lived, widespread and intense	Long-lived, very widespread and particularly intense

Rainfall Outlook



✓ Flooding will be minor and localized.



Key Points

- ✓ Line of thunderstorms expected this afternoon/evening.
- ✓ Main threat for severe weather approximately 5PM-10PM
- ✓ Areas east of I-95 have higher chance of severe weather
- ✓ Damaging wind and tornadoes the main threats.
- ✓ Rain will be tapering off to light/scattered showers around midnight.
