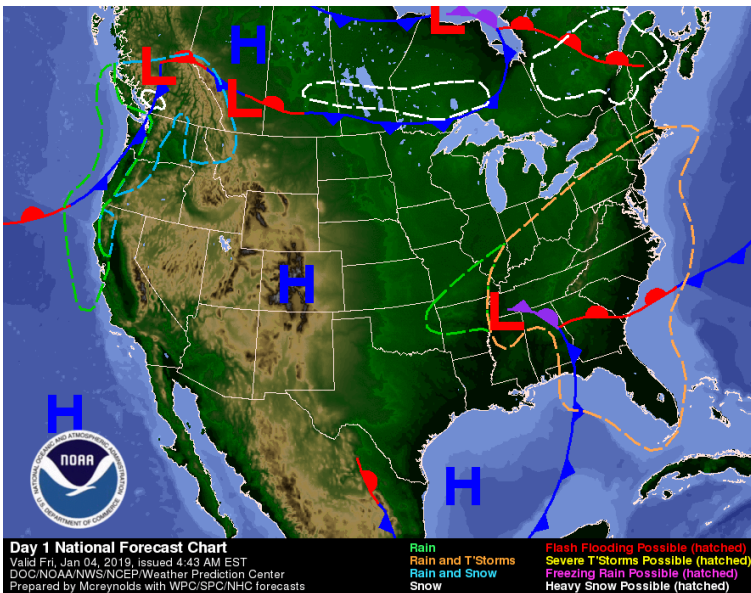

A wet Friday gives way to a nice weekend

Overview: A storm system will bring moderate to heavy rain today into tonight. High pressure will dry the area out Saturday and Sunday.

Impacts: Pockets of minor flooding possible today and tonight; mainly standing water on roads. Heaviest rain (0.75"-1.00") along I-95 corridor.

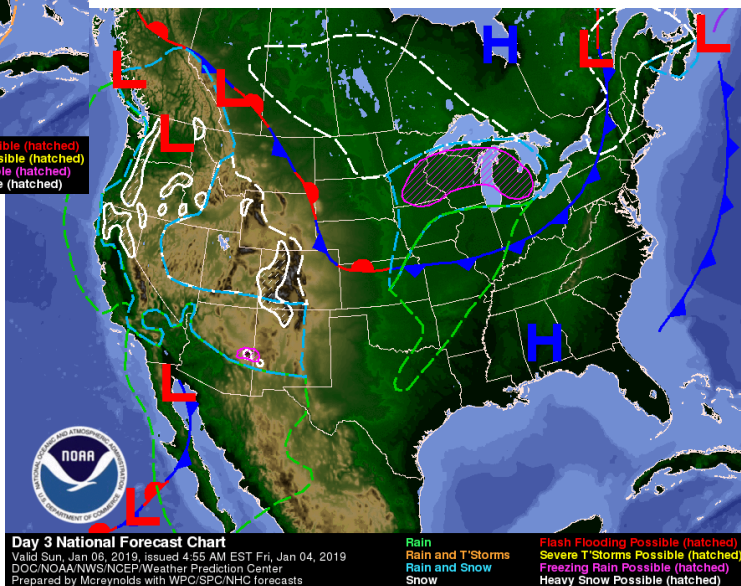
Timing/Confidence: Good confidence with the timing of heavy rain and isolated minor flooding coming late this afternoon/early tonight including evening commute.
