Pender County offices closed, transfer station remains opened

BURGAW – Pender County offices will be closed Friday, April 19, and Monday, April 23 in observance of the Easter holiday.

However, Pender County Utilities (PCU) will keep the Hampstead transfer station open Friday, Saturday, and Monday. The transfer station will close on Easter Sunday.

All convenience sites in Pender County will remain open on their regular schedule during Easter weekend.

“Residents will need to have their updated solid waste decals displayed. If residents have not received their new decals in the mail, they can pick them up at the Hampstead transfer station as long as they bring their tax bill showing the proper code for proof of payment,” said Kenny Keel, Pender County Utilities director. “Without a tax bill showing proof of payment our personnel can’t issue an updated decal over the holiday period. During normal office hours, residents can also receive new decals at the utilities offices in Burgaw.”
