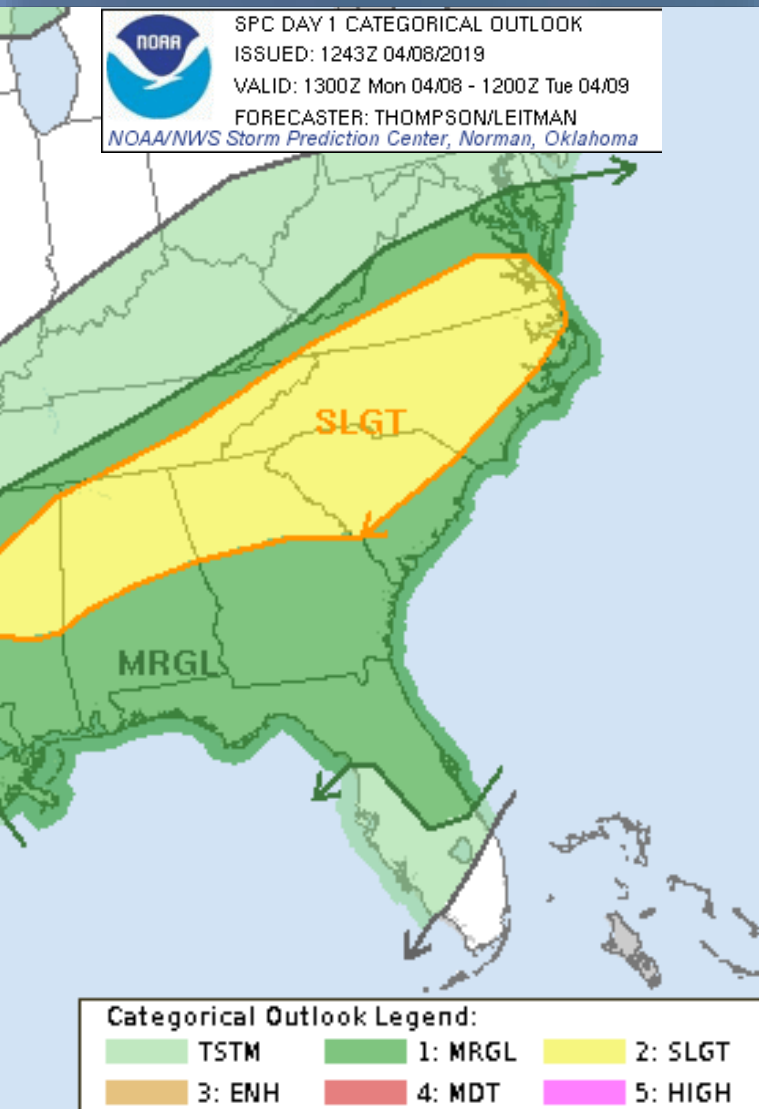

Highlights

- Strong storms expected this evening into the overnight hours.
 - **Slight Risk** for Severe Weather tonight
- Showers with isolated thunderstorms are possible for the day on Tuesday with a cold front passing in the evening.
 - **Marginal Risk** for Severe Weather on Tuesday
- Clearing skies with seasonable temperatures Wednesday and Thursday.
- Showers possible Friday evening ahead of yet another cold front.

Severe Weather Outlook: Today



Dominant Hazard(s): Damaging wind and hail possible.

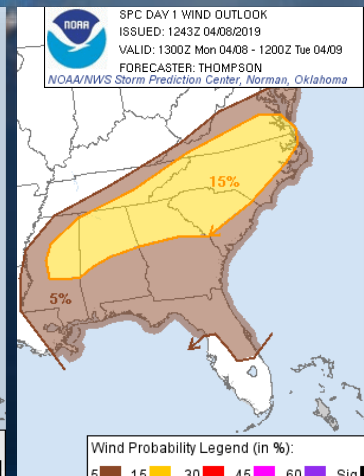
Timing: This evening and overnight

Location: Mainly inland, but severe storms are still possible along the coast.

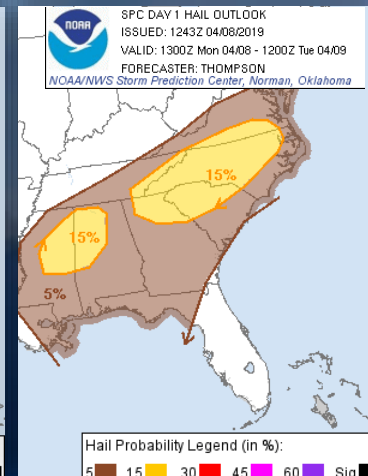
Confidence: Moderate/High confidence inland, lower confidence for coastal areas.



Tornado Probability



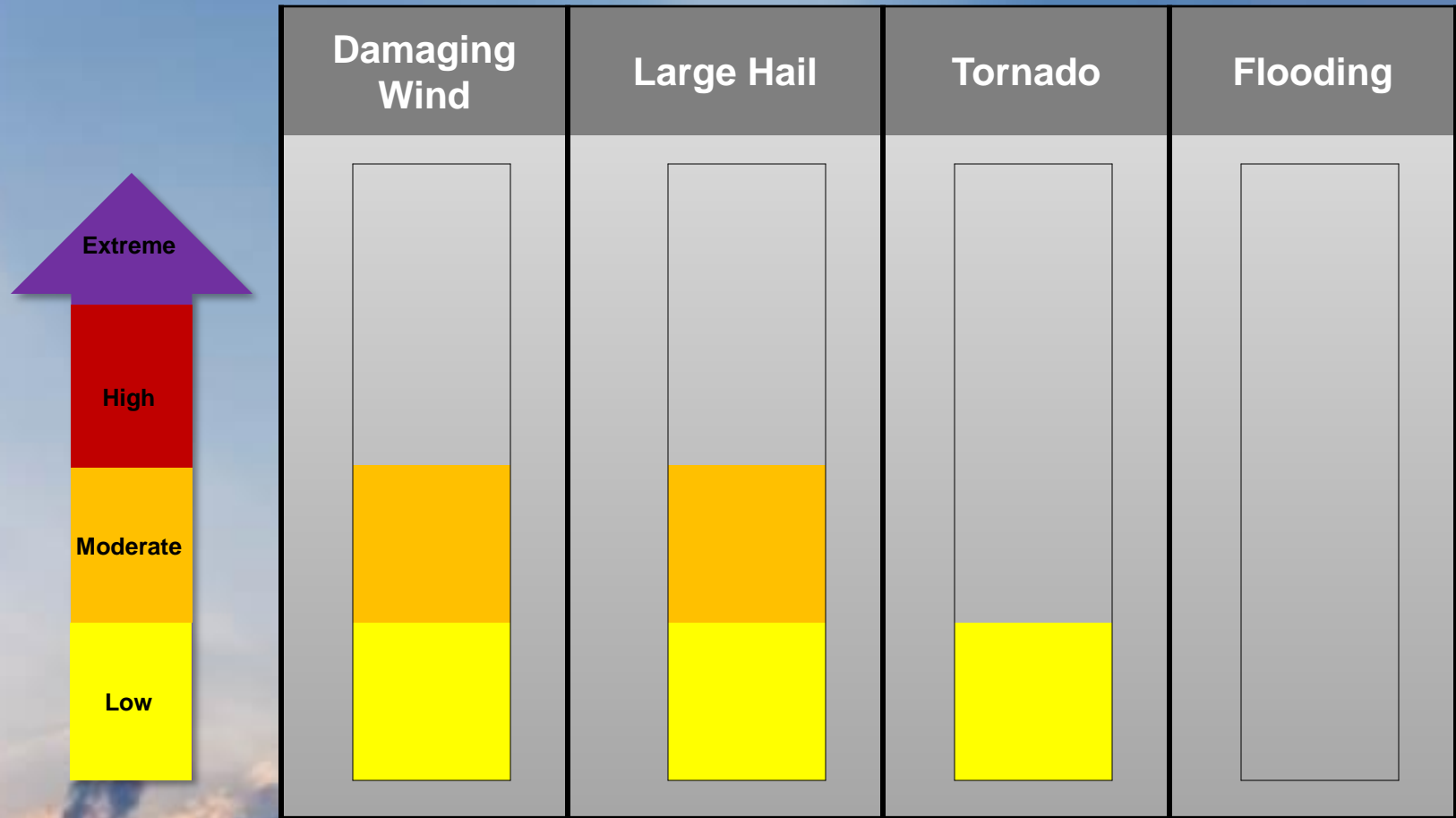
Damaging Wind Probability

Potential Impact Levels

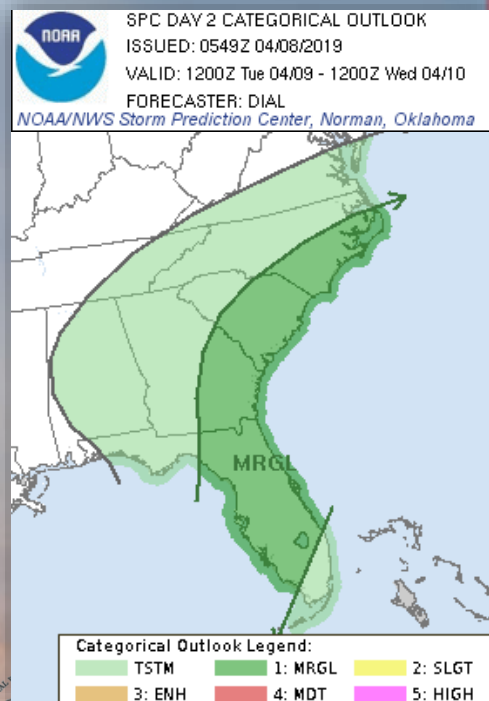
Greatest Impacts anywhere in northeast South Carolina or southeast North Carolina



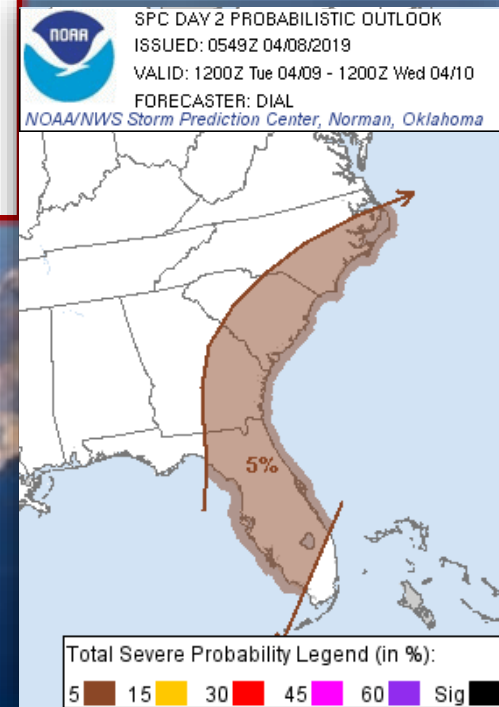
Severe Weather Outlook: Tomorrow

Marginal Risk Tuesday for Damaging Wind & Hail

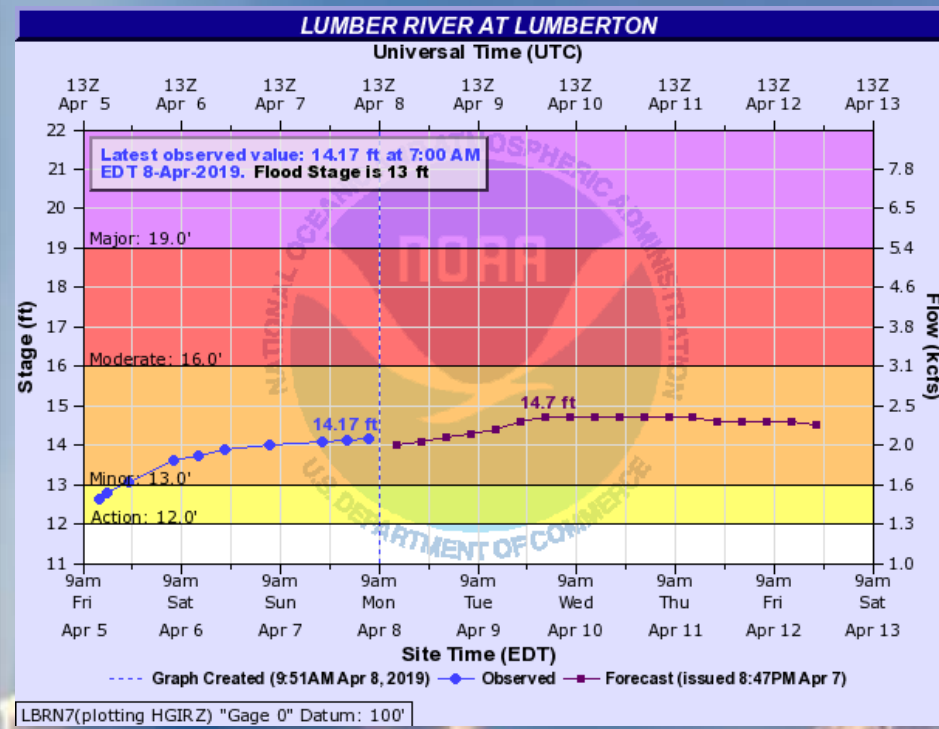
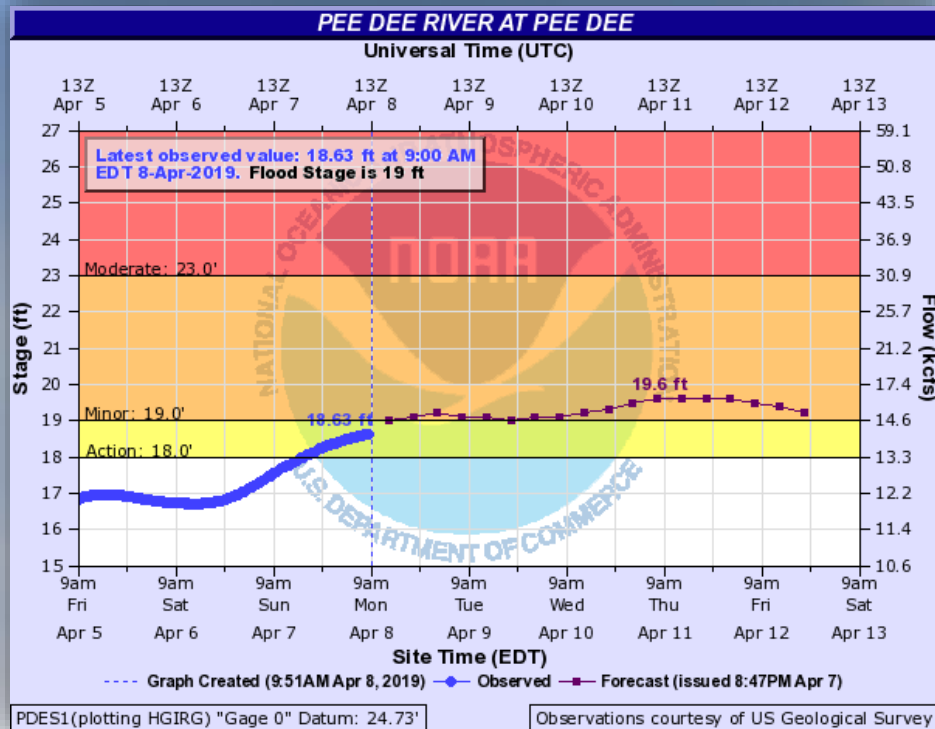


Tomorrow's Severe Weather Outlook



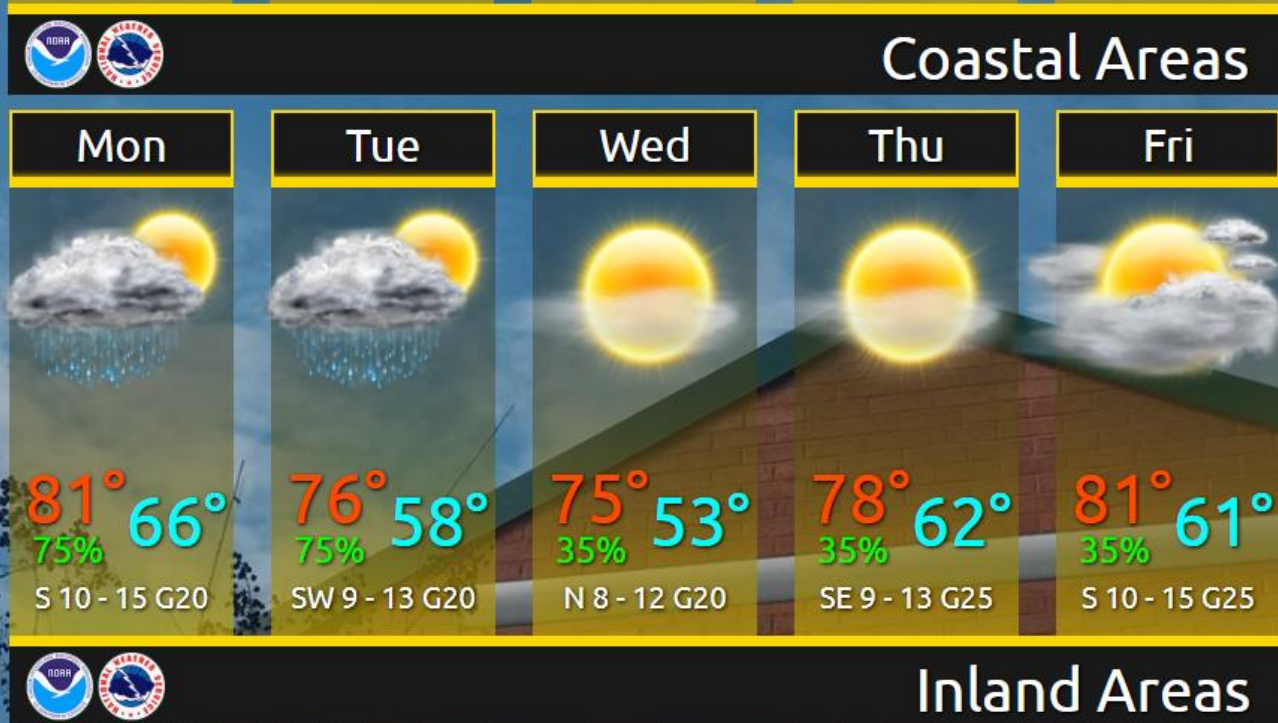
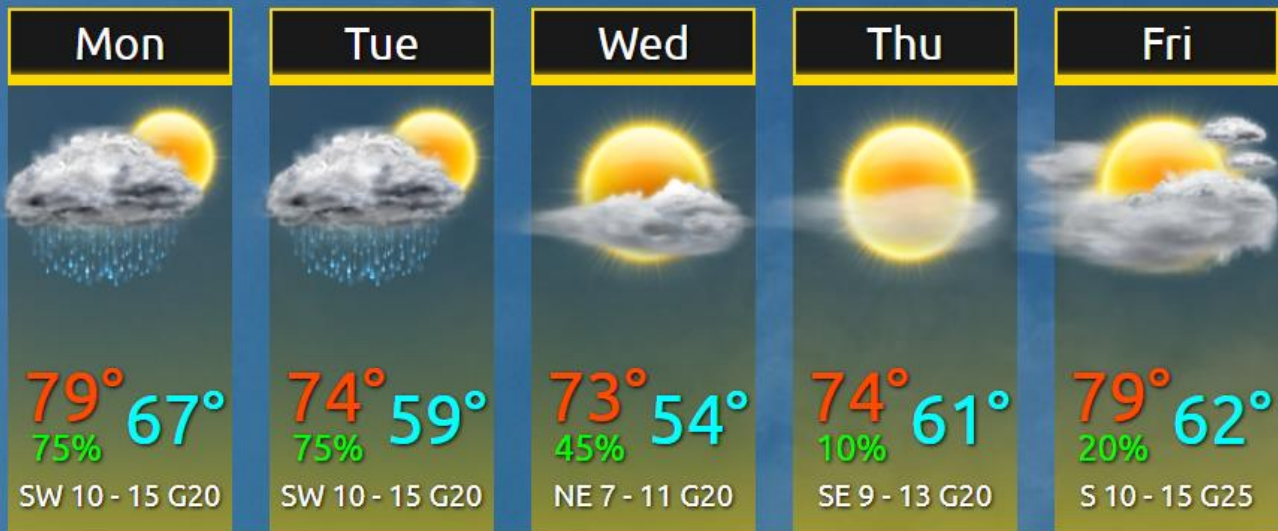
Tomorrow's Severe Weather Probability
