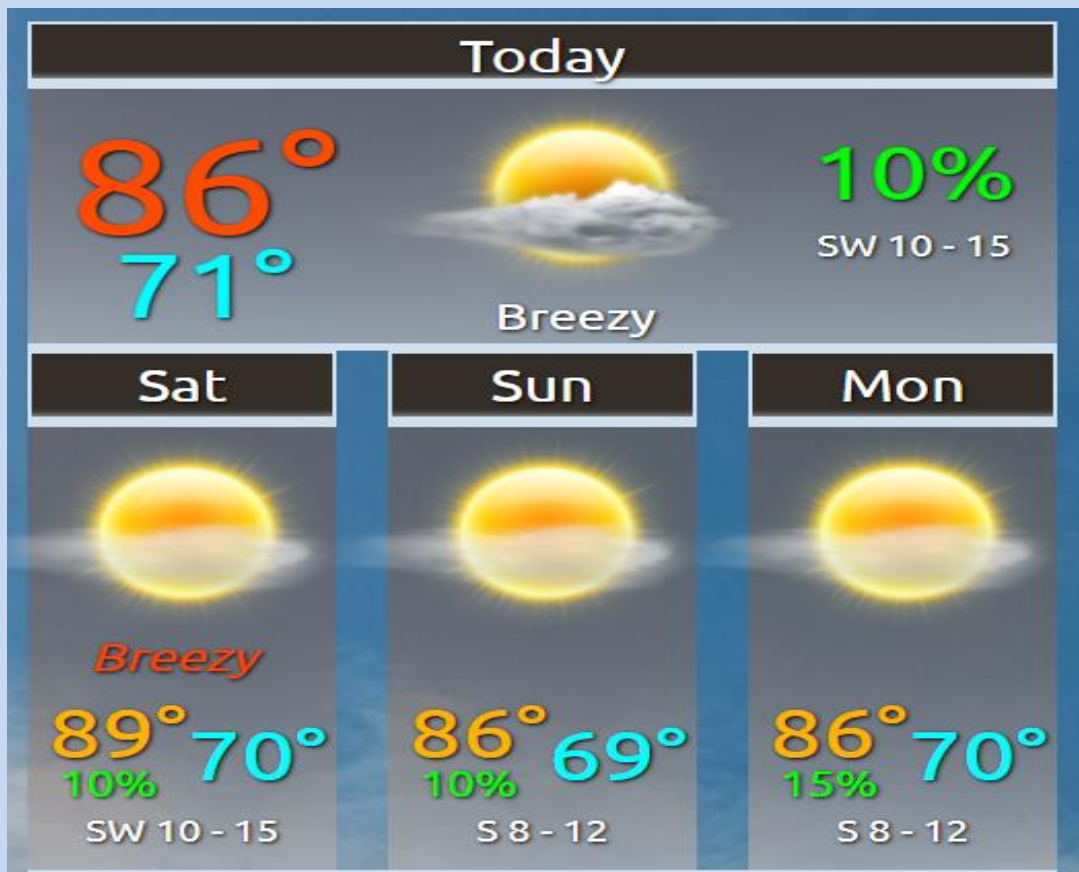

Warm-Up Expected This Weekend

Impacts: Heat exhaustion/illness possible for those spending time outdoors for those sensitive to heat. Protection from the sun will be needed with high UV indices.

Timing/Confidence: High confidence, especially during the afternoon hours.

Overview: Building upper level high pressure system will bring increasingly warm temperatures this weekend into next week. Afternoon high temperatures in the upper 80s to lower 90s, with heat indices as high as the mid 90s Saturday. A stray shower or thunderstorm is possible through the weekend.
