Cool high pressure will build into the area through Saturday, with a warming trend expected early next week as high pressure slips offshore. This will draw south and southwest winds across the region. Expect high temps in the 80s every day.

Minor coastal flooding possible at Cape Fear River at Wilmington for both this evening's and Saturday evening's high tide cycle (see below).


Otherwise, no Advisories, Watches, or Warnings expected through this weekend.
