





Outlook Period: Monday Oct 21 – Friday Oct 25, 2019 Time Issued: 1030 AM Monday Oct 21, 2019

...Risk of severe thunderstorms Tuesday, otherwise dry until late week...

Overview: A cold front will move across the area during Tue resulting in scattered showers & tstms, some of which may be severe. Dry weather will prevail Wed-Fri morning. Another front will approach during Fri afternoon/night resulting in additional rainfall chances.

Impacts: Slight risk for damaging wind gusts Tue along with a risk for isolated tornadoes. The risk will be greatest during the day Tue with conditions improving by Tue night.



Forecast Rainfall Amounts through Friday Night: Average a quarter inch or less, possibly a half inch to an inch across far northwestern areas.
