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OVERVIEW:

A cold front pushes farther offshore today, ushering in the coldest airmass thus far this fall. Dry weather expected this weekend. After a chilly Saturday (highs in mid 50s), expect warming temperatures into Sunday (highs in mid 60s) and Monday (highs near 70).

LAND Hazards:

Freeze Warning and Frost Advisory tonight for areas away from the coast. Frost again possible Saturday night.

MARINE Hazards:

A Small Craft Advisory currently in effect ends mid morning Saturday.

HYDROLOGY:

No river flooding expected through this weekend.

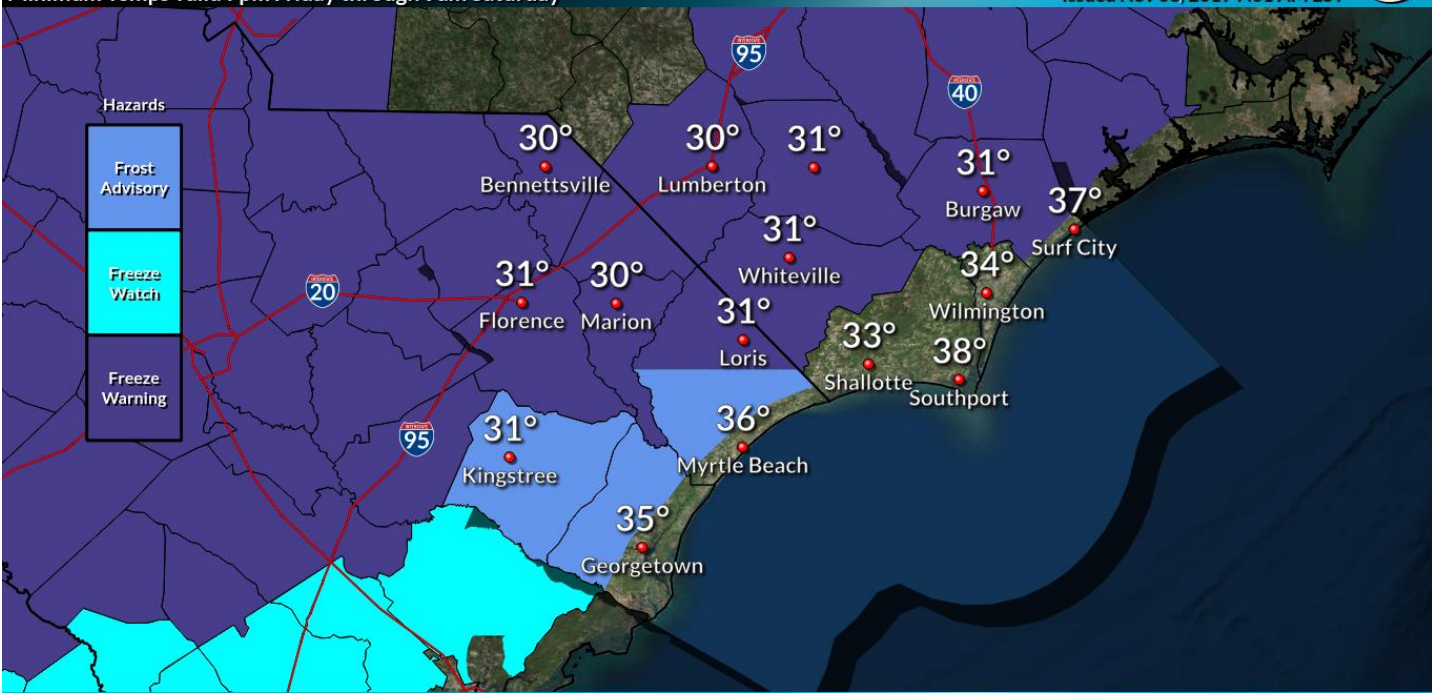
