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
Highlights

- Cold fronts will cross Southeast North Carolina and Northeast South Carolina late Tuesday and late Thursday.
- Showers and an isolated thunderstorm and possible Tuesday and again Thursday night into Friday evening.
- Rain amounts on Tuesday are expected to be less than 0.25" with higher amounts closer to the coast.
- Rainfall amounts Thursday afternoon through Friday evening will range from 0.10" to 0.50" across the entire region.
- High and low temperatures will be slightly above normal before a cooler than normal temperatures Friday into the weekend.











Monday Afternoon Through Tuesday Afternoon
