Today/Tonight

Overview: Cold front approaches the area late Saturday before stalling on Sunday. Rain chances increase late Saturday through Monday, with chance of thunderstorms. Unseasonably warm temperatures today through mid-week.

Primary Threat: Marginal Risk for isolated severe weather late Saturday, after 8pm, through Sunday. Primary threat will be gusty winds.

Impacts: Isolated thunderstorms possible Saturday night through Monday. Small Craft Advisory in effect for coastal waters 10pm tonight through 6pm Sunday. Sea fog may develop Saturday night through Tuesday.

Other: Storm total rainfall through Monday is 0.25"-0.5" on average.


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
