Overview: Quiet conditions today will give way to breezy weather along with a slight chance of showers Tuesday as a cold front moves across the area. Above normal temperatures are expected again by Friday as another cold front approaches from the west. Rain chances will increase again as well toward the end of the week.

Impacts:

- Gusts to around 25 mph expected Tuesday
- Small Craft Advisory conditions likely across adjacent marine areas Tuesday, and again during Friday.
- A couple area rivers are expected to be in minor flood including the Pee Dee at Pee Dee, and the Lumber River at Lumberton
