



Special Wastes

The following materials are also accepted at the specified convenience sites listed below. Refer to “Recycling Information and Sites” for site addresses. Household items and construction debris heavier than 200 pounds may be taken to the Transfer Station for a disposal fee based on weight. The Transfer Station also offers free recycling of appliances and empty refrigerators and up to 5 tires per day per residential household.

Yard Waste

State law prohibits the disposal of yard waste and vegetative debris in sanitary landfills. Consider backyard composting or contracting with a private hauler.

Branch and Brush Debris Depot, a new Hampstead-based business located at 21435 U.S. 17, will accept any vegetative debris that can be burned. Pull-up service is available Mondays – Fridays, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m., Saturdays, 8 a.m. – 3 p.m. For more information call 910-581-1719.

American Property Experts, 606 Sunny Vale Dr. in Wilmington, will accept yard waste for a fee of \$25 per pick-up truck load.

Construction Materials

Only accepted at Burgaw, Rocky Point, Willard, and the Transfer Station.

Roofing materials, wood, wood pallets (**must be broken down**), sheetrock, and other similar materials under 200 pounds. This service is for **RESIDENTIAL USE** only.

Bulky Furniture

Only accepted at Burgaw, Rocky Point, Willard, and the Transfer Station.

Couches, mattresses, box springs, and other furniture under 200 pounds. **RESIDENTIAL USE** only.

Electronics

Only accepted at Rocky Point, Willard, and Hampstead.

Computers and mainframes, monitors, televisions, telephones, cell phones, fax machines, office equipment, printers, copiers, rechargeable batteries, stereo equipment, game consoles, and PDAs.

What must be disposed of: laptops, hard drives, and towers.
